8 Best Practices to Prevent Covid 19 at AGUMCC

Daily Check In

- All adults and children are to take a health screening and temperature check before arriving at school.
- Upon arrival adults and children will go through a health screening by an AGUMCC staff member.
- Any person who has a temperature of 100.4 or above and has any symptoms such as, but not limited to, a runny nose, coughing, difficulty breathing, chills, headache, or sore throat will be sent home.

Masks/Face Shields

- Adults are to wear masks/face shields while at school.
- Children over the age of 2 should wear face masks when social distancing is not possible.

Drop Off and Pick Up

- Adults and children are to use hand sanitizer upon arriving and departing school.
- Limit drop off and pick up to the same people daily

Social and Physical Distancing –

- Children will remain in small groups and not co-mingle with other groups throughout the day to the best of our ability.
- Staff will educate, model, and provide visual aids for social distancing.
- A limit of 2 children will be in each activity area in the classroom.
- Staff will remain with the same designated children throughout the day; both inside and outside.

Increase Handwashing

- Adults and children entering the classroom are to wash their hands upon arrival and before going home.
- Throughout the day adults and children will frequently wash hands. EX: leaving and re-entering the classroom, before and after eating and after using the toilet.

Increased Daily Cleaning

- All surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized/disinfected at the beginning, though out the day, and at the end of day; throughout the school,
- Frequently touched items and surfaces will be cleaned after each group.
- Each classroom and office has an Air Purifier System.

Drinking Water, Snacks and Lunch

- Each family is to provide a lunch and snack(s) for their individual child.
- Each classroom and outside areas will have portable water, where staff will serve the water in disposable cups.

Center Closure Considerations

- If in the event AGUMCC experiences an exposure of Covid 19, we will do everything to limit the spread of the illness.
 - Dismissal of the individual will occur immediately for 2-5 days.
 - Parents/Guardians will be notified of an exposure after verification by a physician.
 - Local Health Officials will be notified after verification.
 - Continued dismissal of the individual, closure of a classroom, or the AGUMCC facility will be determined by the local health officials.

AGUMCC will follow Community Care Licensing, CDC, and CA Dept. of Health cleaning guidelines and best practices.
