Welcome to AGUMCC's 19th year! We are so glad that you have chosen AGUMCC to provide your child with the best care and early childhood education. Currently, our program has 32 students. Word of mouth is our best advertisement. Thank you for telling others about us! We still have openings in our Preschool Class for children who can use the toilet successfully on their own and 2.5 years old.

Share your summertime fun with us. Bring pictures or souvenirs to share from your family travels. Summer is a busy time for many families, as well as for the staff. Please let your child's teacher know if they will not be attending school due to vacation or illness. Teachers record absences related to illness on their classroom illness log.

We appreciate your support in helping to keep everyone healthy. A well-balanced diet, plenty of rest, and regular hand washing are KEY to happy and healthy children, families, and staff. At the beginning of each day, we ask that your child use hand sanitizer or wash his/her hands when entering the program. As we travel from place to place, we also bring germs with us, and we'd like to keep them from spreading as much as possible. Also, children are to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer when leaving school. This will help prevent taking germs home.

What makes AGUMCC different from other childcare centers? We offer a low child-to-teacher ratio. In the toddler program, we maintain a 4:1 ratio. In our preschool and Pre K classes, it is 6:1. We pride ourselves on having a quality program that offers an Emergent Curriculum. Emergent means following the children's lead and introducing new and exciting activities to sustain the children's interests over time. This type of curriculum is socially and intellectually engaging and personally meaningful to the children.

School will be closed on Thursday, July 4 to celebrate Independence Day. School is open on Friday, July 5.
