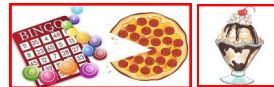

 But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and
 they woke him up and said to him, 'Teacher, do you
 not care that we are perishing?' He woke up and
 rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, 'Peace! Be still!'
 Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead
 calm. He said to them, 'Why are you afraid?
 Have you still no faith?' And they were filled with
 great awe and said to one another, 'Who then is
 this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?'
